

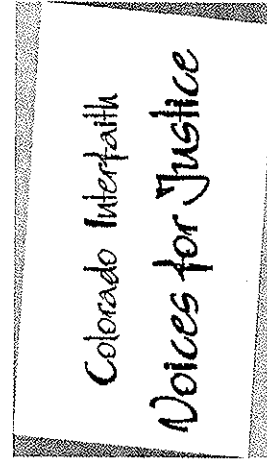
Put the NO in November
Vote No on the Ballot Measures in 2010!

Vote NO on Proposition 101 — Proposition 101 would reduce funding for State government by 25%, causing huge cuts to human services programs, higher education and healthcare funding.

Vote NO on Amendment 60 — Amendment 60 would repeal and override hundreds of local elections and dramatically decrease local government education funding.

Vote NO on Amendment 61 — Amendment 61 would not allow Colorado to carry any debt and prevent projects such as repairing bridges, crumbling school buildings, libraries and recreation centers.

Vote NO on the "Right to Health Care Choice" Amendment — this Amendment would opt Colorado out of national healthcare reform and take away health care options for Colorado.
