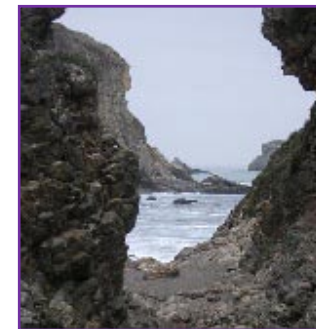

DanaLee Simon



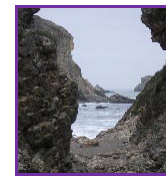
