**budgeted income** \$1,499, 931    **actual income** \$1,454,807 (97%)  
**budgeted expense** \$1,499,931    **actual expense** \$1,490,710 (\$9221 under budget)  
Current income shortfall of \$35,903 as compared with actual expenses.

## Resolution: to keep everyone safe

**A**t the Rocky Mountain Synod assembly in May, voting members adopted a resolution to "provide synod-wide training to church leaders in *Safeguarding God's Children*, an established and recognized training program in sexual abuse awareness, providing tools for clergy, Christian educators, youth ministers, nursery workers, council members and all who work with minors in our churches, to keep everyone safe."



*Safeguarding God's Children* provides participants with a basic understanding of the dynamics of child sexual abuse. The 3-hour course includes information on how to respond, prevent and protect the children and youth in one's congregation and ministry.

The initial training opportunity will be offered prior to and following the 2011 Theological Conference. Those attending the conference are encouraged to select one of the two opportunities. Others not attending the conference may also register.

The instructor is Nancy Bond O'Neal, a licensed insurance broker and certified risk manager who has been serving synods and congregations in Region 2 of the ELCA since 1995. She is also on the Board of Directors of the Evangelical Lutheran Education Association (ELEA). Nancy is a certified trainer for *Safeguarding God's Children*, having presented this workshop to more than 4,000 pastors, lay employees and volunteers throughout the country. The program was designed by the Episcopal Church Pension Group and is used extensively throughout the ELCA.

2011 Theological Conference is opportunity to experience the liturgies

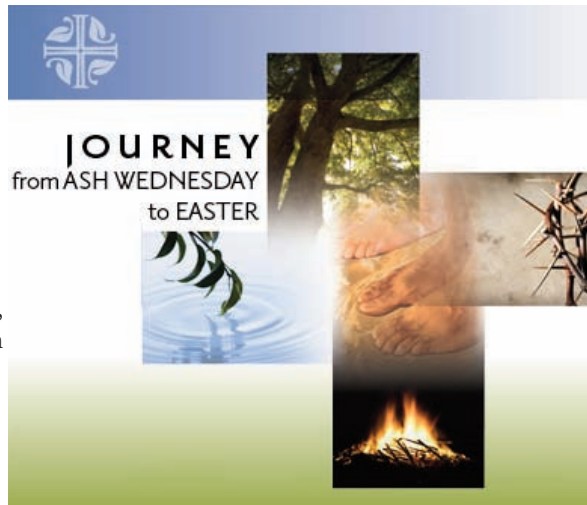
**E**vangelical Lutheran Worship invites us to keep Ash Wednesday through Easter in a new – old way. At the 2011 Rocky Mountain Synod Theological Conference, January 24-27 in Boulder, Colorado, we will worship using the liturgies for Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Vigil of Easter, and join in reflection, study, and discussion of the cross and empty tomb, baptism and Bible – the meaning of this journey for ourselves and the world.

Rostered leaders, worship planners, liturgical artists, worship leaders, musicians, media teams, and anyone interested in enriching their congregation's worship life by exploring these renewed, yet ancient, liturgies are invited to attend. The conference is designed both for those who know these liturgies deeply as well as those who may be experiencing these services for the first time.

All participants can retreat from their usual leadership roles, worshipping at the four liturgies. Each service will be preceded by a time of communal preparation and followed by small group reflection, large group learning, and an opportunity to select from one of three tracks for in-depth study and reflection:

- pastoral/theological
- musical
- artistic/practical

All sessions will help participants imagine ways to make these liturgies come alive in their own unique context.
