[The Hunger Network](#) is a web of lay and rostered congregational contacts who work to increase awareness about the realities of hunger and poverty and to raise money for the ELCA World Hunger Appeal.

From its beginnings, the network has been organized by conferences with the goal of having a dedicated contact in every congregation.

The Core Team

At the center of the Hunger Network is a small group of people willing to work across the synod to tell the amazing story of the ELCA's hunger and poverty work...pretty much whenever and wherever they are invited to do so!

The team's primary function is to recruit, train, and support contacts in congregations and generally inspire EVERYONE to participate in the work of ELCA World Hunger and to give generously.

The Core Team needs to have an accurate and current list of contacts in order to communicate with and support the network. Pastors and other contacts are encouraged to make sure the person working on hunger issues for their congregation is known to the Core Team.

The Core Team also needs additional members willing to work in the synod-wide ministry. Because the team meets via WebEx, members do not have to live along the Front Range of Colorado. Anyone with a computer and separate phone line can be on this team.
