- Become confident and skilled in stewardship development

Key Congregational Commitments:

- Faithfully attend 7 in-person or electronic software meetings with GSB consultant throughout the May 2019-May 2020 year
- Participate fully in implementing SAS strategies into your congregation
- Share stories so others may learn
- Report results and complete financial reports as requested

The Cohort 3 cost is \$2900, plus the cost of a professional graphic artist (\$675 if contracted through SAS). Available Scholarships based on operating budgets of congregations are:

- 5 scholarships of \$1000 over \$300,000
- 5 scholarships of \$1500 under \$300,000
- 5 scholarships of \$2000 under \$200,000
- 5 scholarships of \$2500 under \$100,000
