- the church use technology in the website, online Bible studies, online classes, advertising, and outreach through multimedia.
- the internal church personnel adapt to and utilize IT modernization best-in class methodologies to streamline communication, improve collaboration, automate and simplify wherever possible, access documents and data from any mobile device, interactively edit documents together, use video conferencing if unable to be onsite, directly access documents from the Cloud versus downloading attachments and having outdated documents.

Qualifications

This person would need heart for worshipping God, be able to work as a team and take direction, have experience in audio equipment, video equipment, the internet, YouTube, multimedia, new technologies and new strategies on how to use tech to the church's advantage.

Tasks

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- Train and maintain volunteers for video presentations at worship.

- Research and make suggestions, train staff to put classes, meetings and bible studies online.
- Research and make suggestions to better use technology to reach people in and outside the congregation.
- Research and make suggestions for internal IT modernization to improve/ be more efficient at collaboration, communication, email, use email lists, video conferencing, documentation: spreadsheets, presentations, file repository & version control (no attachments, knowing where most current version).
- Make suggestions for tech equipment that is needed now and in the future.
- Repair or have repaired faulty equipment.
- Regularly evaluate and assess online media presence.
- Research and make suggestions for a church app. Then maintain the church app.
- Set up and schedule posts to social media accounts, including Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.
- Compile and create various analytics reports to measure things like Bethel's social media presence, "hits" on the webpage.
- Create a monthly report to the church council, i.e. list of monthly activities
- Be a part of the weekly staff meeting.
- Provide an IT Tips/best practices training for 15 minutes at Bethel Council meetings.
