Camino de Vida (CdV), located in the South Valley of Albuquerque, provides several ministry opportunities to a diverse, Hispanic/Latino community – embraced by nearly 185 men, women, young adults, youth, and children. At large, the congregants are newly arrived immigrants whose primary language is Spanish, coming from a variety of cultural backgrounds such as, Mexican, Puerto Rican, Guatemalan, Cuban, Chilean, and Hispanic Americans.

The CdV congregants and community members of the South Valley participate in: **Sunday Worship Service, Bible Study, Vacation Bible School (VBS), Music Class, English as Second Language Class, annual events and service opportunities, and connect groups** for both **Women and Young Adults**.

In our 8th year of ministry, Camino de Vida has provided ESL classes to Beginner, Intermediate, and Conversational levels, donated over 45,000 pounds of food per year to local families in the South Valley, celebrated eight baptisms, offered summer classes and activities for the children, such as **Paul's Mission Trips** VBS program, piano and guitar classes, and concluding the year by hosting our 8th Annual Christmas Celebration. In addition, youth and families were eager to be involved and volunteer in the community for Thanksgiving Day, preparing holiday food boxes, and participating in an Ecumenical Prayer Service.
