OUR MISSION: While promoting unity, we celebrate diversity and the sacred humanity of every child of God. Through the collaborative efforts of our 13 covenanting denominations, 850 congregations, and several affiliated partners in ministry, the CCC fosters Christian Unity and interfaith relationships. We are blessed that the Rocky Mountain Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America is one of our covenanting denominations and a financial supporter.

The CCC hosts a number of ecumenical activities to build relationships. Our most well-known ecumenical activity is the annual Easter Sunrise Service at Red Rocks Amphitheatre. Since 1947, we have annually shared the Gospel with 11,000 worshippers, on average.
