Briefly describe your sense of God calling you into mission and service in the Synod through this nomination.

Global mission is, to me, so important (but not for the reason many would suppose). It allows us the opportunity to engage with our siblings in Christ around the world, not just pour Christianity on them. But to have meaningful conversations across artificially constructed boarders. This allows space for creating multidirectional relationships where all partners gain and share of themselves.
